The federal Student Right-to-Know law requires completion/graduation and transfer-out rates of full-time, first-time-in-college, degree/certificate-seeking students be made available to prospective and current students.

Brookhaven College	8%	42%
Cedar Valley College	13%	34%
Eastfield College	6%	40%
El Centro College	7%	28%
Mountain View College	10%	30%
North Lake College	8%	43%
Richland College	10%	40%

* **Transfer Rate** – This rate includes students who transferred to another college within the Dallas County Community College District (during their last semester enrolled) as well as to other community colleges and universities.
