

Fall 2002 Credit and Final Spring 2002 Enrollment Report

The Fall 2002 semester set record highs for credit contact hours and student counts for the District. Contact hours increased 9% (college range = 5.8% to 15.1%) and student count increased 10.1% (college range = 5% to 17%) compared to the prior fall semester.

In conclusion, a comparison of the above *Final Spring 2002* semester to the prior *Final Spring 2001* semester results in a 9.1% contact hour growth and 10.5% student increase.
