Remediation Success and DCCCD Graduates

Students who complete an Associate Degree are likely to have *arrived* at the DCCCD with less than college-level academic skills. Of the 2,275 degrees awarded during 2002-03, 58% went to students who had been enrolled in at least one developmental course. Certificate completers were less likely to remediate, although a substantial proportion (40%) had prior developmental enrollments.
