The federal Student Right-to-Know law requires completion/graduation and transfer-out rates of full-time, first-time-in-college, degree/certificate-seeking students be made available to prospective and current students.

Richland College	10%	42%

* **Transfer Rate** – includes students who transferred to another college within the Dallas County Community College District as well as to other community colleges and universities.
