Top 10 Departments and Top 10 Credit Courses

The top 10 departments by percent of total fall credit enrollments for 2006 - 2008 are listed below. (*Table A*) English, Developmental Math, History and Government departments are listed consistently as the top four departments. The remaining top departments are English for Speakers of Other Languages, Math, Psychology, Biology, Physical Education and Speech.

Top credit courses by enrollment and percent of total credit enrollment for Fall 2006 - Fall 2008 are shown in *Table B*. ENGL 1301 continues to be the top credit course by enrollment. Other top credit courses include HIST 1301, GOVT 2301, PSYC 2301, SPCH 1311, HIST 1302, ENGL 1302, GOVT 2302, DMAT 0090 and DMAT 0097.
