

Top 10 Departments and Top 10 Credit Courses

Departments by percent of total credit enrollment for Fall 2000, Fall 2002 and Fall 2004 are listed below in **Table A**. Credit courses listed by enrollment and by percent of total credit enrollment for Fall 1998, Fall 2000, Fall 2002 and Fall 2004 are shown in **Table B**.

While English (ENGL1301) is listed consistently as the single top credit course since Fall 1998 (see **Table B**), it does not appear at the top of the list for *departments* (see **Table A**). Instead the Developmental Mathematics department tops the list.

It is interesting to note that the Computer Information Technology department is not listed among the top 10 departments for either Fall 2000, Fall 2002 or Fall 2004, but was ranked as the 3rd top department five years ago. However, this area is listed among the top 20 departments and is a compilation of several departments (e.g., ITSC, COSC, ITSW, and ITSE) --- courses offered are identified by WECM (*Workforce Education Course Manual*) course numbers. History ranks as the 3rd top department for Fall 2000, Fall 2002 and Fall 2004.

Biology, English for Speakers of Other Languages and Physical Education consistently rank among the top ten departments (see **Table A**), but do not rank at all among the top 10 credit courses listed in **Table B**.
