SEMESTER-BY-SEMESTER MAP FOR FULL-TIME STUDENTS

This pathway is an example course sequence for students interested in pursuing Kinesiology. You must receive a GPA of at least 2.00 on all college-level course work. Students must earn at least 25% of the credit hours required for graduation through instruction by Dallas College. SEMESTER 1

Total Hours: 16

ENGL 1301 – Composition I *This is a (CB 010) Core course. Must earn a grade of "C" or higher.*

HIST 1301 – United States History I *This is a (CB 060) Core course.*

MATH 1342 – Elementary Statistical Methods *This is a (CB 020) Core course. Must earn a grade of "C" or higher. There are several options to fulfill this requirement. Contact your academic advisor for a specific list. UNT Dallas requires MATH 1342 for this pathway.*

EDUC 1300 – Learning Framework *All college students with fewer than 12 semester credit hours of successful college credit (grade of "C" or above) must take a student success course in the first semester.*

PHED 1164 – Introduction to Physical Fitness and Wellness *This is a (CB 090) Core course. There are several options to fulfill this requirement. Contact your academic advisor for a specific list.*

KINE 1301 – Foundations of Kinesiology *Course should be selected according to the intended university you will transfer to. Consult with your academic advisor to choose an appropriate elective.*

SEMESTER 2

Total Hours: 13

ENGL 1302 – Composition II *This is a (CB 010) Core course. UNT Dallas requires a grade of "C" or higher.*

HIST 1302 – United States History II *This is a (CB 060) Core course. There are several options to fulfill this requirement. Contact your academic advisor for a specific list.*

KINE 1338 – Concepts of Physical Fitness *Course should be selected according to the intended university you will transfer to. Consult with your academic advisor to choose an appropriate elective.*

PHED X1XX – Any 1-hour Physical Activity Course

CHOOSE ONE: **SPCH 1311** – Introduction to Speech Communication **OR**

SPCH 1315 – Public Speaking **OR**

BIOL 2401 – Anatomy and Physiology I *This is a (CB 030) Core course. This course has a prerequisite of BIOL 1406 with a grade of "C" or better within the last three years or satisfactory score on the Biology CLEP exam, prior to enrolling in the course. There are several options to fulfill this requirement. Contact your academic advisor for a specific list. UNT Dallas requires BIOL 1406 for this pathway.*

KINE X3XX – Kinesiology Specialization Course *Course should be selected according to the intended university you will transfer to. Consult with your academic advisor to choose an appropriate elective.*

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CHOOSE ONE: **ENGL 2321** – British Literature **OR**

ENGL 2326 – American Literature **OR**

ENGL 2332 – World Literature I *These are (CB 040) Core courses. There are several options to fulfill this requirement. Contact your academic advisor for a specific list.*

GOVT 2306 – Texas Government *This is a (CB 070) Core course.*

BIOL 2402 – Anatomy and Physiology II *This is a (CB 030) Core course. There are several options to fulfill this requirement. Contact your academic advisor for a specific list. UNT Dallas requires BIOL 1407 for this pathway.*
